School of Prayer:

Layout:

The modules are both lecture and activation based. The lessons are broken up roughly as follows:

10 minutes of interactive worship

20-40 minutes of teaching

10-20 minutes of workshopping or prayer

Week 1 - The Temple

Beginning with an introduction on "what is prayer?" We will learn the "Place", "Practice" and "Purpose" of prayer. The "Place" of prayer brings us to our first lecture where we will look at basic "Temple Theology" and arrive at the place Paul arrived at when he said, "Do you not know that YOUR BODY is the temple of the Holy Spirit"

What does that mean for our prayer life to know that WE are the meeting place for God?

Week 2 - The Royal Priesthood

From understanding the "Place" of prayer we move to the "Practice" of prayer. We will learn that the ministry of prayer belongs to the Holy Spirit. Jesus is our High Priest and we are the Royal Priesthood. Praying becomes a relationship with God where we are not generating prayer but simply entering into the prayer that is happening in God.

When you discover what Jesus is praying your prayer life will be dramatically altered!

Week 3 - Authority and Unity in Prayer

In this lecture we will look at the "Purpose" of prayer. To love God is the answer but a second answer is like it. What role does prayer play in loving and serving others? Serving others will lead you to discover the needs that others have. What, then, does it look like to have authority in prayer to bring about justice in peoples lives? Where does that authority come from? What are the guidelines to using that authority? These are some of the questions posed in this lecture.

Hint: Love is the answer!

Week 4 - The Many Faces of Prayer

Here we will get to learn the many, many aspects of prayer. From contemplation to intercession to the ecstatic and back again, understanding each manifestation of prayer will help us to find God in the seasons of our prayer life. A disciplined prayer life simply looks like turning up, what happens from there is utterly dynamic!

This lecture is much more interactive.

Week 5 - Giants Fall Through Prayer

This is a declaration! Not just a lecture. Looking at the stories through scripture we will learn from the giant slayers and their tools and keys to victory eventually landing on Jesus who took down the ultimate giant with a cross! We will then learn how to face our giants and take them down too.

It's time to see some changes in our lives.

Week 6 - City Transformation Series

Learn practical ways that you can pray for your city such as prayer walking, spiritual mapping, identificational intercession and have an influence within your surroundings. Learn to listen to God, see your city with prayerful eyes, know where to target your prayers, learn what stands in the way of breakthrough and then go about releasing the blessing in prayer that will see those changes take place.

School of Worship:

Week 1 - Mosaic Worship

Worship starts with seeing God. And Moses saw the Glory of God pass before him and was subsequently handed the entire Priestly Worship system to reveal God to the Israelites.

In this lecture we will look at the central focus of Mosaic Worship, the sacrifice, and how that translates to our central focus of worship, the Lamb that was slain.

Week 2 - Worship in the Key of David

David was a man after Gods own heart and through his reign as the king of Israel he ushered in a monumental shift in the practice of worship and kickstarted a whole new era of approach to God.

His tabernacle of worship opened up such deep dimensions of the Spirit that he ended up before the cross of Christ and wrote it down for all to remember!

Week 3 - The Worshipping Saviour

Jesus life, death and resurrection was the climax and fulfilment of the Mosaic age of worship practice. Everything had been pointing to Christ and when he came he offered himself to God as the perfect sacrifice. He also fulfilled the Davidic vision of worship by opening up the True tabernacle of David to us all.

In his lecture we will look at the life and final moments of Jesus on the cross and how this act was THE perfection of worship.

Week 4 - Rebuilding the Tabernacle of David

The New Testament model for worship is in the "spirit" of the Tabernacle of David. Peter quotes Amos 9:11 when he says that in these days we will rebuild the tabernacle of David and have free flowing, spirit lead, 24/7 prophetic worship.

In this lecture we will unpack what that looks like and how we can set ourselves to co-labour with the Lord in participating in that task.

Week 5 - The Harp and Bowl

Diving into the book of Revelation we will see what John saw on the isle of Patmos in visions of God. The book of Revelation offers us an insight into what is happening in the spirit in the temple of our hearts!!

We will use this to see get some keys to help us in the rebuilding of the tabernacle of David here in our day

Week 6 - The Moravian Lampstand

Any time in ancient or recent history when there has been continuous, uninterrupted worship offered to the Lord, immense blessing and grace is poured out on the Land.

A small community of Moravians tapped into the power of this reality when they worshipped non-stop for 100 years and launched one of the greatest missionary movements the world has seen. Come and hear their story!

Week 1 - Fasting: The Body, Soul and Spirit

In this lecture we will introduce you to what fasting is and how it affects the body, the soul and the spirit. Fasting is ancient and deeply spiritual but not always the most understood practice. We will learn the benefits and debunk the myths

Week 2 - Fasting for Social Change

Fasting is a form of self mastery and can be applied to all areas of life. We will see how fasting has been employed for social change, protest, social justice. How can we adopt a lifestyle of fasting that takes care of ourselves, each other and the world we live in? Find out here!
